

- What if my artwork doesn't win?**
If your artwork is unsuccessful in winning the 2013 Cliftons Art Prize, you are welcome to collect your artwork after the conclusion of the Exhibition Period on Monday, 19 August. Otherwise, all artworks will be donated to Cliftons.
